Whitefield Academy offers selected scholarships in a variety of categories which are detailed on the school's website. Whitefield's scholarship program is intended to assist qualified students and their families in receiving a Christian education.

The admissions process must be completed before scholarships are awarded. Scholarships are awarded based on the qualifications of the applicant compared to the criteria of each scholarship. The total funds available for our scholarship program are determined each year by the school board.

In order to qualify, applications must be submitted by current families no later than March 1. Families new to the school should submit applications within two weeks of submitting the enrollment application. A new application with the required supplemental information as specified for each scholarship is required for each school year. Applications

are not accepted after the first day of school.

Please note that Whitefield limits the total amount of funds awarded to each family under its Financial Aid and Scholarship programs to 50% of tuition. This limit allows everyone in the school community to share in the cost of education.

Completed applications should be emailed, mailed or delivered to the school office in a sealed envelope marked "Scholarship Application". Each application will be reviewed by the Financial Aid Committee which may request additional information to determine eligibility. Each applicant will receive a written response concerning their application.

Scholarship Programs

Novus Transitus Scholarship

This scholarship is for students new to Whitefield. This Latin phrase speaks of “a new transition” which we believe incorporates the feeling of new students when they begin their academic journey at Whitefield.

Eligibility

1. Student must not have attended Whitefield Academy previously.
2. Student must be entering grade levels 4-12.

Amount

Scholarship is \$250 per student with a maximum of \$750 per family.

Doulos Scholarship

This scholarship is for pastoral families that select Whitefield. The Greek translation speaks to the servant attitude demonstrated by pastors in their daily duties. We at Whitefield desire to honor this commitment and sacrifice.

Eligibility

1. At least one parent with financial responsibility must be an ordained minister currently leading a church as a senior or assistant pastor as a primary means of employment and income in a full-time capacity. This scholarship is not available for ministers engaged in other ministry activities, non-profit organizations, schools or similar endeavors.
2. Applicant's total household income, including housing allowance and other benefits, may not exceed \$100,000. Families must submit a current tax return as proof of income.
3. Families must submit proof of current employment with a church and a letter from the governing body of the church specifying the role, hours and nature of the applicant's position with the church.

Amount

Scholarship is \$1,000 per student.

Omnis Scientia Scholarship

This scholarship is to recognize outstanding academic achievement in our current student body. Our motto begins with the phrase “all knowledge” and while we cannot teach students all knowledge in their academic years at Whitefield, we can achieve teaching them how to think which will serve them throughout their lives.

Eligibility

1. Student must have been enrolled at Whitefield for at least the last two full years.
2. Student must be entering grades 9-12.
3. Student must have maintained a 4.0 GPA for both of the last two years.

Amount

Scholarship is \$350 per student.
